Activity 3: Earning Money - brainstorming chores

Dear Parents,

Activity three is all about chores! In Workbook 1, we introduced your child to the concept of chores. Now that your child is older and more capable of helping around the home, it's time to really get thinking about what chores your child might be able to do to earn their pocket money.

This activity asks your child to think of as many chores as possible, and to list them on a mind map. They will then be using this mind map as a resource for activity four, where they will be making a chart of all the chores that they think need doing at home.

Learning Outcome

On completion of this activity, your child should:

- Have brainstormed chores and then negotiated with you a set of chores that they are able to do each week to earn their pocket money, thus getting them used to the concept of earning money.

Activity 3: Earning Money - brainstorming chores

Write down as many different jobs around your house that you can think of... each of them is a chore that might be able to earn you some pocket money!
